Additionally I will begin to work on base line assessments for alphabet and number knowledge. These assessments will take form in games they will play one on one with me. My goal is to make it fun

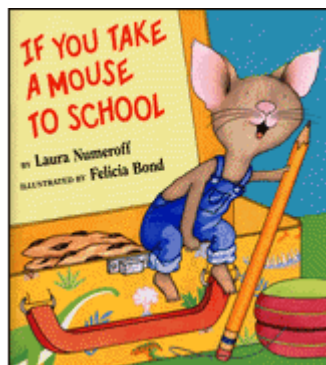
so that ideally your child will not realize he or she is taking a "test".
