

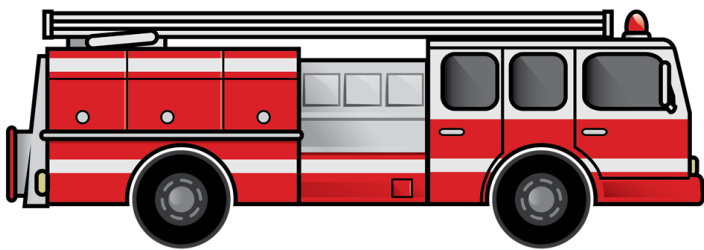


A Peek at Our Week

Welcome Back!



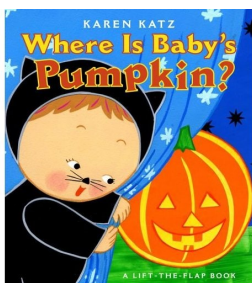
